Commenting on your annual general meeting, CDC wish a very successful meeting in all the agendas you have outlined. It is good to discuss C.M.C. issue because women are just waiting from us. Indeed Vocational training for our children will be very important at your meeting, because as you are aware that our boys and girls have nothing to do after school due to problems of getting employed. As a result of this our youth just wander around Chipungu without doing anything. For your information, the youth Vocational Centre hall is completed which was under construction. But it is empty without furniture in it.

Building of a school block at Chipunga is a very welcome issue, which must be fully discussed at your meeting, since the school lacks school blocks and teacher's houses as well. This is the only school where our children go to learn.

C.D.C. Convinced a meeting where we invited the school committee, Parental Teachers Association (P.T.A.) Committee, Teachers and Village headmen in order to hear their views on the issue. The meeting was held at Chipunga Primary School on 11-02-007. These people were very happy to hear the news and they ^{are} very willing to contribute to this project by mending more bricks to add on what they have already at the school. At the meeting it was discovered that the school also lacks the following things: Note books, Pencils, pens and water. The school committee told us that the ministry of ~~education~~ education accepts any plan of a school block or teachers house can be constructed at the school.
